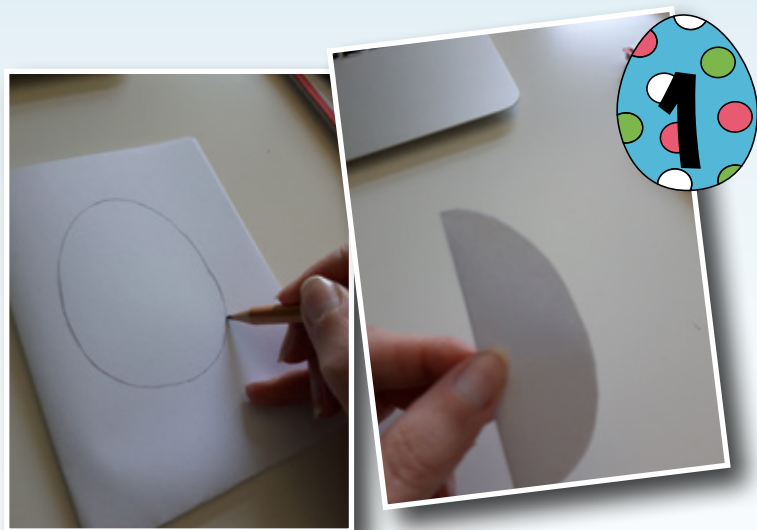

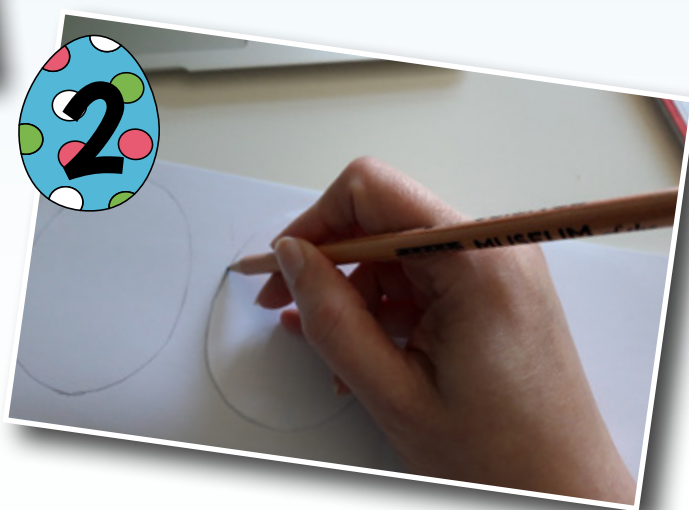
Easter Egg Decoration

You will need: a pencil, paper/wrapping paper/old comic books or magazines, coloured pencils, scissors, glue, ribbon/string/cotton thread.

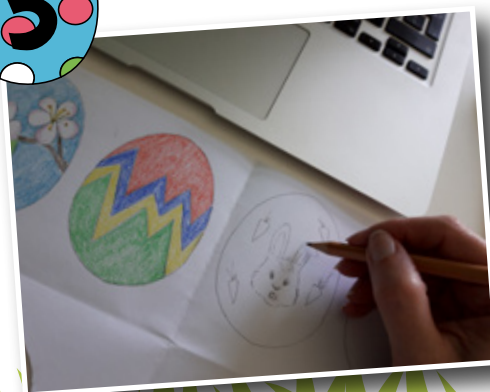


Draw an egg shape on to paper or card. Cut it out, fold it in half lengthways to check that it is roughly symmetrical

Use this as a template to draw around. You will need at least 3 eggs to make your decoration 3D, I used 6 in my example but it's up to you.



Decorate the eggs with drawings and patterns, or you could use pages from old comic books or magazines, or wrapping paper. Cut them out.

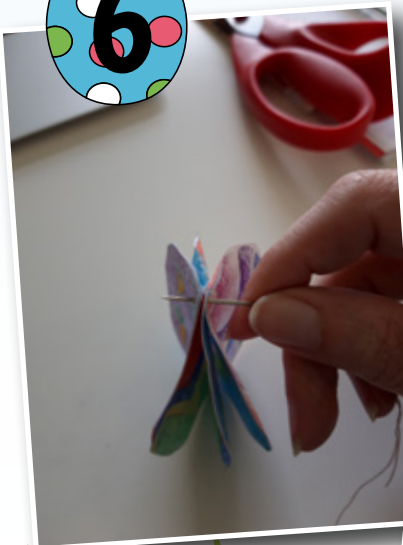
Fold all of your eggs lengthways, with the decorated side facing inwards

Glue the back of one half of an egg and stick it to another. I didn't have craft glue at home so I had to improvise with a mix of a little flour and water to make a paste. Repeat until you have stuck all of your eggs together.

When the glue has dried poke a hole through the top of your egg, thread with ribbon, string or a piece of cotton thread and knot the top. I used some leftover Christmas wrapping ribbon.

You can now hang your decoration up around the house!
