**Project Brief:**

The Harris was founded with the vision of providing the people of Preston with free access to knowledge and learning which is perfectly summarised by the scripture on the façade of the building “The mental riches you may here acquire abide with you always”. One of the key functions of the Harris to this day remains its educational offer, to this end the Harris would like to invite you to submit your proposals for new learning resource packs.

The Harris aims to provide learning opportunities for people of all ages and backgrounds, for individuals and families. These learning opportunities take many forms, from ICT classes, Arts Workshops to seed planting workshops.

While it is not mandatory to link submissions with each criteria applicants should outline how their proposals meet at least two of the below criteria:

- Accessible
- Encourages sustainable learning
- Link with the Harris Collections
- Link with Preston History
- Promotes family learning

Worksheet proposals should be aimed at those wishing to complete activities while onsite within the galleries and therefore should take into consideration the limitations of the space. For this reason worksheets should be designed to be completed with a pencil only.

The video guides should be designed for people to follow along with while at home and will be hosted on the Harris website. These guides are therefore not limited as to the items people can use, however they should focus on items which would be reasonable for people to have at home and where possible encourage recycling.

Applications should be no longer than 1 side of A4 and include the below:

- What format the resource will take (Paper/PDF or video)
- Outline of the proposed resource
- How the proposed resource links with the Harris & its collections
- What age group is the resource aimed at
- Examples of previous work (if relevant)

- If proposing a video resource should also provide the equipment which will be used to produce the piece and any examples of previous videos produced.
