Rail Cover Usage Guide







Tying instructions

To give the cover more stability it is important to fasten all the ties in a particular manner. Please see details below:

<u>Lower Central Calico Ties</u> - Wrap tightly underneath point where the main vertical bar and the feet sections intersect, wrapping round twice and securing with a knot.

<u>Lower Cotton Ties</u> – Wrap tightly around the foot bars twice at the bend point and secure in a tight bow.

<u>Top Ties</u> — (These should only be tied once garments have been placed on the rail.) With one person at each side carefully bring the sides of the cover up, being careful not to crush any of the garments. Once the cover is in place; tightly tie the cotton ties around horizontal bar twice, then twice around the vertical bar. Secure with a tight bow.



Overhang

Place one side of the overhang over top of the rail, ensuring it lays flat. Then place the second side over the top, again ensuring it lays flat. Use a clamp to hold the cover in place at both ends of the rail. IMPORTANT: Make sure you do not catch any of the garments or hangers in the clamp. If there are any large gaps in the sides either tuck the fabric in a manner that covers these or pin the fabric in place.

Before moving double check that the cover is off the floor and adjust if necessary.
